2. Proceedings on an enquiry under Part I of the Incumbents (Vacation of Benefices) Measure 1977 conducted by a provincial tribunal.	The incumbent concerned in the proceedings and any of the persons mentioned in paragraphs (b), (c) or (d) of section 7(5) of that Measure.
3. Proceedings under Schedule 4 to the Pastoral Measure 1983 (including any interview by a pastoral committee).	Any person having a right to compensation conferred by paragraphs 1, 2, 3, or 4 of the said Schedule 4.
4. Proceedings under Schedule 4 to the Pastoral Measure 1983 as extended by subsection (3) of section 13 of the Incumbents (Vacation of Benefices) Measure 1977 (including any interview by a pastoral committee).	Any incumbent having a right to compensation conferred by subsection (1) of the said section 13.
