#### PROVISIONS FOR GIVING EFFECT TO OTHER AGREEMENTS

- 4 Articles 29 and 31 in Schedule 1 to the <sup>M1</sup>Diplomatic Privileges Act 1964 (inviolability and immunity from jurisdiction and arrest of diplomatic agents and exemption from duty to give evidence) may be extended to members of a consular post and members of their families forming part of their households.
