1984 CHAPTER 37

PART I

OFFENCES UNDER LAW OF ENGLAND AND WALES

4 Penalties and prosecutions.

(1) A person guilty of an offence under this Part of this Act shall be liable—

- (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, ^{F1}. . . or to both such imprisonment and fine;
- (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven years.
- (2) No prosecution for an offence under section 1 above shall be instituted except by or with the consent of the Director of Public Prosecutions.
