



# Crossbows Act 1987

## 1987 CHAPTER 32

### 1 Sale and letting on hire.

A person who sells or lets on hire a crossbow or a part of a crossbow to a person under the age of [<sup>F1</sup>eighteen] is guilty of an offence, [<sup>F2</sup>unless he believes him to be <sup>F1</sup>eighteen years of age or older and has reasonable ground for the belief].
