MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

The Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953 (c. 20)

- In section 9(4) of the 1953 Act for "(b) or (c)" there shall be substituted "(b), (c) or (d)".
- In the proviso to section 14(1) of that Act—
 - (a) in paragraph (a) for the word "acknowledging" there shall be substituted the word "stating";
 - (b) in paragraph (b) the words "by an affiliation order or otherwise" shall cease to have effect;
 - (c) at the end of paragraph (c) there shall be added the words "or section 56 of the Family Law Reform Act 1987".
- In section 34(2) of that Act for the words "required by law" there shall be substituted the words "required or permitted by law".
