# Immigration, Asylum and Nationality Act 2006

## 2006 CHAPTER 13

### Employment

#### 22 Offence: bodies corporate, &c.

- (1) For the purposes of section 21(1) a body (whether corporate or not) shall be treated as knowing a fact about an employee if a person who has responsibility within the body for an aspect of the employment knows the fact.
- [<sup>F1</sup>(1A) For the purposes of section 21(1A) a body (whether corporate or not) shall be treated as having reasonable cause to believe a fact about an employee if a person who has responsibility within the body for an aspect of the employment has reasonable cause to believe that fact.]
  - (2) If an offence under section 21(1) [<sup>F2</sup>or (1A)] is committed by a body corporate with the consent or connivance of an officer of the body, the officer, as well as the body, shall be treated as having committed the offence.
  - (3) In subsection (2) a reference to an officer of a body includes a reference to-
    - (a) a director, manager or secretary,
    - (b) a person purporting to act as a director, manager or secretary, and
    - (c) if the affairs of the body are managed by its members, a member.
  - (4) Where an offence under section 21(1) [<sup>F3</sup>or (1A)] is committed by a partnership (whether or not a limited partnership) subsection (2) above shall have effect, but as if a reference to an officer of the body were a reference to—
    - (a) a partner, and
    - (b) a person purporting to act as a partner.
