#### Status

- 42 (1) The Commission shall not—
  - (a) be regarded as the servant or agent of the Crown, or
  - (b) enjoy any status, immunity or privilege of the Crown.
  - (2) Service as Commissioner, Investigating Commissioner or employee of the Commission is not employment in the civil service of the State.
  - (3) The [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] shall have regard to the desirability of ensuring that the Commission is under as few constraints as reasonably possible in determining—
    - (a) its activities,
    - (b) its timetables, and
    - (c) its priorities.
