MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

Criminal Justice and Court Services Act 2000 (c. 43)

- 32 (1) In Schedule 6 (trigger offences), in paragraph 1, omit the entry relating to section 15 of the Theft Act 1968.
- (2) After paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 insert—
- “3 Offences under the following provisions of the Fraud Act 2006 are trigger offences—
- section 1 (fraud)
 - section 6 (possession etc. of articles for use in frauds)
 - section 7 (making or supplying articles for use in frauds).”
