Power to appoint auditor

PROSPECTIVE

#### **39 Power to appoint replacement auditor**

- (1) Where a person appointed by [<sup>F1</sup>the Auditor General for Wales] under this Chapter in relation to an entity for a financial year dies, is dismissed or is unable or unwilling to act, the [<sup>F2</sup>Auditor General for Wales] may (subject to this Chapter) appoint a replacement in relation to that entity for that financial year.
- (2) Before making an appointment under this section the [<sup>F2</sup>Auditor General for Wales] must consult the entity.
- (3) After making an appointment under this section the [<sup>F2</sup>Auditor General for Wales] must notify the local authority with which the entity is connected.
