CHAPTER 85

PRIVY COUNCIL REGISTRAR ACT 1853

- 1 Registrar, may examine witnesses upon oath.
- 2 President of the Council may appoint a person to act for registrar in his absence.
- 3 Saving of the existing powers of Her Majesty, Her Council and the Judicial Committee.
