#### 1887 CHAPTER 55 50 and 51 Vict

#### Definitions and Repeal

#### 38 Definitions.

In this Act unless the context otherwise requires—

[F1The expression "county", in relation to England, means, subject to the provisions of Schedule 2A to this Act, a county for the purposes of the Local Government Act 1972;]

[F2: enforcement officer" means an individual who is authorised to act as an enforcement officer under the Courts Act 2003;]

The expression "writ" includes any process.
