## 1887 CHAPTER 55 50 and 51 Vict

### Miscellaneous

## **30** Filing and exemption from duty of declaration of office.

(1) Every declaration of office made under this Act by a sheriff of a county or his undersheriff shall <sup>F1</sup>. . .be transmitted to the clerk of the peace for the county, and be by him filed among the records of his office.
