## CHAPTER 100

### TITHE ACT 1832

- [1.] What prescriptions and claims of modus decimandi to be valid in law.  
Proviso.
- 2 What compositions for tithes shall be considered valid.
- 3 .....
- 4 To what cases this Act shall not extend.
- 5 Time during which lands shall be held by persons entitled to the tithes  
thereof to be excluded in the computation;
- 6 as also the time during which any person capable of resisting any claim  
shall be an infant, &c.
- 7 .....
- 8 No presumption allowed in support of any claim for any less period than  
herein mentioned.
- 9 Act to extend to England only.
