The Justices of the Peace (Commission Areas) (Amendment) Order 2000

Made - - - - 9th March 2000 Coming into force - - 1st April 2000

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1997(1), makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Justices of the Peace (Commission Areas) (Amendment) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 1st April 2000.
 - (2) In this Order "MCC" means magistrates' courts committee.

Commission areas

2. For the Schedule to the Justices of the Peace (Commission Areas) Order 1999(**2**) there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.
