The Legal Services Act 2007  
(Consequential Amendments) Order 2009

*Made - - - - 15th December 2009*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 2*

The Lord Chancellor makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 208(2) and (3) of the Legal Services Act 2007<sup>(1)</sup>, section 78 of the Mental Health Act 1983<sup>(2)</sup> and section 51 of the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007<sup>(3)</sup>.

The Lord Chancellor has consulted the Administrative Justice and Tribunals Council in accordance with paragraph 24(1) of Schedule 7<sup>(4)</sup> to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007 and the Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales and the Judicial Appointments Commission in accordance with section 51(9) of that Act.

A draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament pursuant to sections 206(5) of the Legal Services Act 2007 and section 51(14) of the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007.
