Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Chief Regulator of Qualifications and Examinations Order 2021 and comes into force on 14th January 2021.

Appointment of chief executive of the Office of Qualifications and Examinations

2. Simon Lebus is appointed as the chief executive of the Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation and is to be known as the Chief Regulator of Qualifications and Examinations, from 14th January 2021.
