

COUNCIL DECISION**of 21 February 1967****extending until 31 December 1967 the authorization granted in Article 1 of the Decision of 19 December 1960 on the system of aid in existence in France for certain types of paper pulp****(67/146/EEC)**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular the third subparagraph of Article 93 (2) thereof;

Having regard to the Council Decision of 19 December 1960¹ on the system of aid in existence in France for certain types of paper pulp;

Having regard to the request by the French Government to the Council for a one-year extension of the authorization granted by the Decision of 19 December 1960;

After consulting the Commission;

Whereas the Council Decision of 19 December 1960 authorized the French Government to pay subsidies under the system of aid to the paper pulp industry until 31 December 1966;

Whereas it seems appropriate, having regard to the multilateral tariff negotiations which are now being

held, to extend the authorization until 31 December 1967,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The expiry date of the authorization, set out in the second sentence of Article 1 of the Council Decision of 19 December 1960 on the system of aid in existence in France for certain types of paper pulp, is hereby extended until 31 December 1967.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the French Republic.
