## COMMISSION DECISION

of 17 September 1969

supplementing the Commission Decision of 3 April 1968 authorising certain management measures to be taken within the framework of the common organisation of agricultural markets

(69/299/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

*Article 1*

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities;

The following shall be substituted for the first indent of Article 1 (1) (a) of the Commission Decision of 3 April 1968 authorising certain management measures to be taken within the framework of the common organisation of agricultural markets:

Having regard to the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Commission of 6 July 1967<sup>1</sup>;

— the levies provided for in Articles 13, 14, 15 and 18 of Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC<sup>8</sup> of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organisation of the market in oils and fats and in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of Council Regulation No 162/66/EEC<sup>9</sup> of 27 October 1966 on trade in oils and fats between the Community and Greece, and the levies referred to in Article 6 of Regulation (EEC) No 1466/69 and Article 6 of Regulation (EEC) No 1471/69.<sup>7</sup>

Whereas, by its Decision of 3 April 1968,<sup>2</sup> as supplemented by the Decisions of 2 July 1968,<sup>3</sup> 24 July 1968<sup>4</sup> and 23 July 1969,<sup>5</sup> the Commission instituted machinery for authorising certain management measures to be taken within the framework of the common organisation of agricultural markets;

*Article 2*

Whereas Council Regulations (EEC) Nos 1466/69<sup>6</sup> of 23 July 1969 on imports of olive oil from Morocco and 1471/69<sup>7</sup> of 23 July 1969 on imports of olive oil from Tunisia provided for the fixing of a special import levy on olive oil from Morocco and Tunisia; whereas the considerations which led the Commission to institute the machinery for authorising the fixing of levies on oils and fats apply also to the fixing of import levies on olive oil from Morocco and Tunisia; whereas the Decision of 3 April 1968 should therefore be supplemented;

This Decision shall enter into force on 19 September 1969. It shall be published in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.
