

COUNCIL DECISION**of 3 March 1970****on the conclusion of an Agreement with Canada negotiated under Article II (5) of GATT
(70/179/EEC)****THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,**

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Articles 113, 114 and 228 thereof;

Having regard to the Council Decision of 5 December 1961;

Having regard to the report from the Commission;

Whereas the Government of Canada has, through a tariff reclassification, modified the scope of a concession affecting the European Economic Community; whereas that modification has been the subject of negotiations for compensatory adjustment under Article II (5) of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade;

Whereas the concessions offered by Canada in compensation for the modified concession are satisfactory,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:*Article 1*

The Agreement negotiated with Canada under Article II (5) of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade is concluded on behalf of the European Economic Community; the text of the Agreement is annexed to this Decision.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade shall be notified of the conclusion of this Agreement.
