DECISION OF THE COMMISSION

of 15 April 1970

amending the Decision of 17 May 1963 setting up a Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers

(70/254/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to its Decision of 17 May 1963 setting up a Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers, as amended by its Decision of 19 December 1963¹;

Having consulted the Joint Advisory Committee;

Whereas the terms of office of the members of the Joint Advisory Committee on Social Questions affecting Paid Agricultural Workers expire on 19 April 1970;

Whereas the CGT-CGIL Standing Committee has created a European Committee for the Co-ordination of Agricultural Workers' Trades Unions;

Whereas the membership of the Joint Advisory Committee should be enlarged in accordance with the principles laid down by the Commission on 16 April 1969, and the number of seats to be filled should be altered;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Article 3 of the Commission Decision of 17 May 1963 shall be amended to read as follows:

'Article 3

1. The Committee shall consist of thirty-eight members.

2. Seats shall be apportioned as follows:

- to paid agricultural workers, 19;
- to agricultural employers, 19;

Article 2

Article 4 of the Commission Decision of 17 May 1963 shall be amended to read as follows:

'Article 4

1. Members of the Committee shall be appointed by the Commission, on a proposal from the following representative bodies set up at Community level:

- the Committee of Agricultural Trade Organisations of the European Economic Community (COPA);
- the European Federation of Agricultural Workers (CESL) in the Community — EFA;
- the "Agriculture and Food" Working Party of the European Organisation of the World Confederation of Labour (WCL);
- the CGT-CGIL European Committee for the Co-ordination of Agricultural Workers' Trades Unions.

2. ... unchanged.'

Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on 20 April 1970.
