

## THE COUNCIL

### COUNCIL DECISION

of 17 November 1972

adopting a research programme for continuation of the Dragon project  
(72/412/Euratom)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, and in particular Article 7 thereof;

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a single Council and a single Commission of the European Communities;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission, which consulted the Scientific and Technical Committee;

Whereas the Community is interested in continued participation in the Dragon project and whereas a decision in the connection is a matter of urgency,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### *Article 1*

For the period 1 April 1973 to 31 March 1976, a research programme which shall include the continued participation of the Community in the work covered by the 'Agreement for the further extension of the revised Agreement concerning the high-temperature gas-cooled reactor project' (Dragon) shall be adopted.

#### *Article 2*

The financial obligations inherent in respect of this programme shall not exceed 10.63 million units of account.
