

COMMISSION DECISION

of 2 May 1974

authorizing the Federal Republic of Germany to permit, for a period which expires on 31 December 1974, the marketing of commercial sainfoin seed satisfying less stringent requirements

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to the Council Directive of 14 June 1966⁽¹⁾ on the marketing of fodder plant seed, as last amended by the Council Directive of 11 December 1973⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 17 thereof;

Having regard to the request made by the Federal Republic of Germany;

Whereas the production in the Federal Republic of Germany of sainfoin seed (*Onobrychis sativa* L.), satisfying the requirements regarding minimum germination, is not sufficient;

Whereas needs cannot be adequately met by sainfoin seed, satisfying all the requirements necessary for marketing, coming from other Member States;

Whereas the Federal Republic of Germany should therefore be authorized to permit, for a period which expires on 31 December 1974, the marketing of commercial sainfoin seed satisfying less stringent requirements;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the Opinion of the Standing Committee on Seeds and Propagating Material for Agriculture, Horticulture and Forestry,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Federal Republic of Germany is authorized to permit the marketing in its territory, for a period

which expires on 31 December 1974, of a maximum of 150 metric tons of sainfoin (*Onobrychis sativa* L.) seed of the category 'commercial seed' harvested in 1973 which does not satisfy the requirements regarding minimum germination set out in Annex II to the Council Directive of 14 June 1976, provided the following requirements are satisfied:

- (a) germination must be at least 70 % of pure seed;
- (b) the official label must state that the germination properties of the seed are reduced: minimum germination 70 %.

Article 2

The Federal Republic of Germany shall notify the Commission by 1 February 1975 of the quantity of commercial sainfoin seed permitted to be marketed in its territory pursuant to this Directive. The Commission shall inform the other Member States.

Article 3

This Decision is addressed to the Federal Republic of Germany.
