

## COMMISSION DECISION

of 3 July 1974

revoking the Commission Decision of 12 June 1974 amending the Commission Decision of 8 May 1974 whereby the Italian Republic was authorized to take certain safeguard measures under Article 108 (3) of the EEC Treaty

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community and Article 108 (3) thereof;

Whereas, by its Decision of 8 May 1974<sup>(1)</sup>, the Commission authorized the Italian Republic to require, with regard to imports of certain goods, proof of cash payment of a deposit corresponding to 50 % of their cif value; whereas, by the Decision of 12 June 1974<sup>(2)</sup>, the assessment of the deposit was adopted; whereas the Italian Republic informed the Commission of the considerable difficulties caused by the implementation of this Decision, difficulties which were not likely to compensate the effects normally produced by this implementation;

Whereas it has not been possible to take into account other deposit assessments that were more practicable than the cif value of goods to which import charges have not been added; whereas therefore it is advisable to return to the means of calculating the deposit as

laid down in the Commission Decision of 8 May 1974 and consequently revoke the Decision of 12 June 1974,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The Commission Decision of 12 June 1974 is revoked.

*Article 2*

This Decision is addressed to the Italian Republic.
