

## COMMISSION DECISION

of 5 May 1975

amending the Commission Decision of 4 April 1975 authorizing certain Member States  
to apply special intervention measures for common wheat

(Only the French, Dutch and German texts are authentic)

(75/311/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the  
European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/  
EEC <sup>(1)</sup> of 13 June 1967 on the common  
organization of the market in cereals, as last  
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 665/75 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in  
particular the second paragraph of Article 8 and  
Article 24 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 174/67/  
EEC <sup>(3)</sup> of 27 June 1967 on special intervention  
measures for cereals, as last amended by Regulation  
(EEC) No 445/68 <sup>(4)</sup>, and in particular Article 1  
thereof;

Having regard to the communications from the  
French Republic of 20 March 1975, as amended on  
26 March 1975 and 17 April 1975, from the  
Kingdom of the Netherlands of 18 March 1975 and  
from Belgium of 19 March 1975, as amended on 17  
April 1975, from the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg  
of 19 March 1975 and from the Federal Republic of  
Germany of 19 March 1975 describing the  
particularly difficult situation for persons holding  
stocks of common wheat and including requests for  
special intervention measures for this cereal;

Whereas the Commission by its Decision of 4 April 1975  
authorized the application of special intervention  
measures for 1 185 000 metric tons of common  
wheat in certain Member States; whereas, by reason  
of the price of common wheat in France and  
Belgium, which has resulted in applications to the  
French and Belgian intervention agencies for  
quantities greater than those provided for, the  
quantity of 400 000 metric tons provided for in the  
case of France and of 150 000 metric tons in the case  
of Belgium appear insufficient to achieve the objec-  
tives of the special intervention measures; whereas

on the other hand applications to the Dutch,  
Luxembourg and German intervention agencies have  
been less than anticipated; whereas it is therefore  
necessary to increase the quantities for France and  
Belgium and to reduce those for the Netherlands,  
Luxembourg and Germany;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision  
are in accordance with the Opinion of the  
Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

The first paragraph of Article 1 of the Decision of  
4 April 1975 is replaced by the following:

'The following Member States are authorized to  
have their intervention agencies carry out special  
intervention operations for common wheat within  
the framework of the undermentioned provisions:

- the French Republic — 800 000 metric tons,
- the Kingdom of the Netherlands — 175 000  
metric tons,
- the Kingdom of Belgium — 170 000 metric  
tons,
- the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg — 1 500  
metric tons,
- the Federal Republic of Germany — 150 000  
metric tons.'

*Article 2*

This Decision is addressed to the French Republic,  
the Kingdom of Belgium, the Kingdom of the  
Netherlands, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and  
the Federal Republic of Germany.
