

COMMISSION DECISION

of 24 November 1975

concerning the sale of skimmed-milk powder from public stocks to an international organization for supply to a developing country

(Only the Dutch text is authentic)

(75/750/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 ⁽¹⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 740/75 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (5) thereof ;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 155/75 ⁽³⁾ of 21 January 1975, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1960/75 ⁽⁴⁾, provides for the sale of skimmed-milk powder from public stocks for supply to developing countries ;

Whereas the World Food Programme (WFP), an international organization as mentioned in Article 2 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 602/75 ⁽⁵⁾ of 7 March 1975 laying down detailed rules for the sale of skimmed-milk powder in public storage for supply to developing countries, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1996/75 ⁽⁶⁾, has submitted an application to the Commission for 200 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder for supply to Uganda ; whereas this application should be granted and the Dutch intervention agency should be designated to supply the quantity requested ;

Whereas the international organization in question should be exempted under Article 5 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 602/75 from having to provide the security referred to in Article 8 (2) of that Regulation ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION :

Article 1

1. The Dutch intervention agency is authorized to sell, on the terms set out in Regulation (EEC) No 602/75, to the WFP, 200 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder for Uganda.

2. By way of derogation from Article 8 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 602/75, the international organization in question shall not be required prior to taking delivery of the quantity of skimmed-milk powder indicated in paragraph 1 to furnish security.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Kingdom of the Netherlands.
