

COMMISSION DECISION

of 1 October 1984

**fixing maximum amounts for contracts awarded under the tendering procedure
opened by Regulation (EEC) No 2475/84 on the supply of various lots of
skimmed-milk powder as food aid**

(84/485/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68
of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the
market in milk and milk products ⁽¹⁾, as last amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 1557/84 ⁽²⁾, and in particular
Article 7 (5) thereof,

Whereas under Commission Regulation (EEC) No
2475/84 of 27 August 1984 on the supply of various
lots of skimmed-milk powder as food aid ⁽³⁾ tenders
have been invited for the supply of 860 tonnes of
skimmed-milk powder to certain third countries and
certain organizations;

Whereas Article 13 (1) of Commission Regulation
(EEC) No 1354/83 of 17 May 1983 laying down
general rules for the mobilization and supply of
skimmed-milk powder, butter and butteroil as food
aid ⁽⁴⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No
1886/83 ⁽⁵⁾, specifies that in the light of the tenders
received a maximum amount shall be fixed for each
lot, or part thereof if the third subparagraph of Article
11 (3) is used, or a decision shall be taken to make no
award;

Whereas on the basis of the tenders received no
contracts should be awarded;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision
are in accordance with the opinion of the Management
Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

No awards will be made in respect of Lots A and C
under the tendering procedure opened by Regulation
(EEC) No 2475/84.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
