

COMMISSION DECISION

of 12 November 1991

**cancelling Decision 91/147/EEC adopting protective measures against cholera in
respect of imports of fruit and vegetables from Peru**

(91/601/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Directive 90/675/EEC of 10
December 1990 laying down the principles governing the
organization of veterinary checks on products entering
the Community from third countries ⁽¹⁾, and in particular
Article 19 (7) thereof,

Whereas protective measures against cholera in respect of
imports of fruit and vegetables from Peru were adopted by
Commission Decision 91/147/EEC ⁽²⁾; whereas in view of
the urgency of the situation the Commission adopted on
its own initiative the said Decision; whereas the situation
has worsened since then and countries bordering Peru
have also been affected by cholera;

Whereas there is a risk that the epidemic might spread
even further; whereas it is advisable therefore to replace
the safeguard measure in respect of Peru by a wider and
more general Community Regulation; whereas it is
advisable to establish a simplified procedure allowing
frequent and rapid amendments to the Community Regu-
lation according to the development of the situation;
whereas the Commission shall present proposals on this
subject to the Council;

Whereas it is advisable, in these circumstances, to cancel
Decision 91/147/EEC;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in
accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary
Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Decision 91/147/EEC is cancelled.

The cancellation shall take effect on the day of entry into
force of Council Regulation (EEC) No 3185/91 of 22
October 1991 adopting measures in respect of imports of
fruit and vegetables from certain regions affected by
cholera ⁽³⁾.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
