## ANNEX

Specific conditions applying to plants, originating in the Republic of Korea, benefiting from the derogation provided for in Article 1 of this Decision

3. Prior to export to the European Community, the plants shall have been grown, held and trained for at least two consecutive years in officially registered nurseries, which are subject to an officially supervised control regime. The annual lists of the registered nurseries shall be made available to the Commission, at the latest by 1 March [<sup>F1</sup> each year]. These lists shall be immediately transmitted to the Member States. They shall include the number of plants grown in each of these nurseries, as far as they are deemed suitable for dispatch to the Community, under the conditions laid down in this Decision.
