COUNCIL DIRECTIVE

of 6 March 1970

amending the Directives of 27 June 1967 and 13 March 1969 on the approximation of laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous substances

(70/189/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DIRECTIVE:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 100 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas Article 10 of the Council Directive of 27 June 1967¹ on the approximation of laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous substances, and Article 2 of the Council Directive of 13 March 1969² amending that Directive, lay down that Member States should adopt the measures needed in order to comply with those Directives and apply them by 1 January 1970;

Whereas unexpected difficulties have arisen in the course of the work in connection with the implementation of those Directives; whereas, therefore, it is advisable to extend the above time limit;

Article 1

The time limit laid down in the first paragraph of Article 10 of the Council Directive of 27 June 1967 and in the first paragraph of Article 2 of the Council Directive of 13 March 1969 shall be extended to 1 January 1971.

Article 2

This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
