COUNCIL DIRECTIVE

of 16 November 1976

amending Directive 75/432/EEC on aid to shipbuilding

(76/872/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community, and in particular Articles 92
(3) (d) and 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Directive 75/432/EEC of 10 July
1975 on aid to shipbuilding ⁽¹⁾ establishes a new cate-
gory of aid which may be considered compatible with
the common market;

Whereas Directive 75/432/EEC stipulates uniform
principles, as required by Article 113, for the applica-
tion of the schemes of cost escalation insurance for
exports of ships to third countries;

Whereas, more particularly, Article 2 (2) (b) and (3) of
Directive 75/432/EEC specify the terms on which
such schemes may be operated;

Whereas the United Kingdom scheme of cost escala-
tion insurance is designed to facilitate the reorganiza-
tion of the structure of the United Kingdom ship-
building industry by keeping enough business going
for the reorganization to be conducted in an orderly
and progressive fashion; whereas it may therefore be
brought within the Directive if it conforms to these
uniform principles;

Whereas Directive 75/432/EEC should be amended
accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DIRECTIVE:

Article 1

The following fourth indent is added to Article 2 (2)
(b) of Directive 75/432/EEC:

‘— in the United Kingdom, in the form of a
scheme of cost escalation insurance, provided
that the terms of the scheme are made progres-
sively more restrictive.’

Article 2

This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
