ANNEX II

MINIMUM HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR WORKPLACES ALREADY IN USE, AS REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 4 OF THE DIRECTIVE

- 7. Room temperature
- 7.1. During working hours, the temperature in [^{X1}rooms containing workstations] must be adequate for human beings, having regard to the working methods being used and the physical demands placed on the workers.
