- Article 2 Member States shall establish national occupational exposure limit values for...
- Article 3 (1) Member States shall bring into force the laws, regulations...
- Article 4 Directive 96/94/EC is repealed with effect from the date referred...
- Article 5 This Directive shall enter into force on the 20th day...
- Article 6 This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
