## [F1PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE EUROPEAN UNION MODEL DRIVING LICENCE

## **Textual Amendments**

- 4. Special provisions
- Where the holder of a driving licence issued by a Member State in accordance with (a) this Annex has his normal place of residence in another Member State, that Member State may enter in the licence such information as is essential for administering it, provided that it also enters this type of information in the licences which it issues and provided that there remains enough space for the purpose.
- After consulting the Commission, Member States may add colours or markings, such (b) as bar codes and national symbols, without prejudice to the other provisions of this Annex.
  - In the context of mutual recognition of licences, the bar code may not contain information other than what can already be read on the driving licence or which is essential to the process of issuing the licence.
- (c) [F1 Information contained in the front and reverse side of the card shall be legible with the eye, using a minimum character height of 5 points for items 9 to 12 on the reverse side.]
