

## ANNEX XII

## INFORMATION AND ALERT THRESHOLDS

## A. Alert thresholds for pollutants other than ozone

To be measured over three consecutive hours at locations representative of air quality over at least 100 km<sup>2</sup> or an entire zone or agglomeration, whichever is the smaller.

<b>Pollutant</b>	<b>Alert threshold</b>
Sulphur dioxide	500 µg/m <sup>3</sup>
Nitrogen dioxide	400 µg/m <sup>3</sup>

## B. Information and alert thresholds for ozone

<b>Purpose</b>	<b>Averaging period</b>	<b>Threshold</b>
Information	1 hour	180 µg/m <sup>3</sup>
Alert	1 hour <sup>a</sup>	240 µg/m <sup>3</sup>

**a** For the implementation of Article 24, the exceedance of the threshold is to be measured or predicted for three consecutive hours.

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
