- 1. Characteristics of projects

The characteristics of projects must be considered, with particular regard to:

- the size and design of the whole project; (a)
- (b) cumulation with other existing and/or approved projects;
- (c) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
- (d) the production of waste;
- (e) pollution and nuisances;
- (f) the risk of major accidents and/or disasters which are relevant to the project concerned, including those caused by climate change, in accordance with scientific knowledge;
- the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution).] (g)
