REGULATION No 694/67/EEC OF THE COMMISSION

of 10 October 1967

redefining the destination zones for export refunds on cereals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals, and in particular Article 16 (6) thereof;

Whereas pursuant to Article 16 (2) of Regulation No 120/67/EEC and of Article 6 of Council Regulation No 139/67/EEC² of 21 June 1967 laying down rules for granting export refunds on cereals and criteria for fixing the amount of such refunds, export refunds on cereals and on flour, groats and meal of wheat or rye may be varied according to use or destination;

Whereas for that purpose it would be more convenient to group third countries of destination into a certain number of zones determined with particular regard to geographical situation and to the characteristics of the market in cereals and the market in flour, groats and meal; whereas, moreover, a time limit is no longer required for the provisions of Commission Regulation No 350/67/EEC³ of 26 July 1967 defining destination zones for the

application of export refunds on cereals, as amended by Regulation No 432/67/EEC,⁴ subject, however, to the adjustments dictated by experience;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The destination zones to be used for the differentiation of export refunds shall be as set out in Annex A in respect of products listed in Article 1 (a) and (b) of Regulation No 120/67/EEC, and in Annex B in respect of products listed in Article 1 (c) of that Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

Regulation No 350/67/EEC, as amended by Regulation No 432/67/EEC, shall be repealed from that date.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
