

**REGULATION No 867/67/EEC OF THE COUNCIL**  
**of 14 November 1967**  
**amending Regulation No 362/67/EEC laying down standard qualities for rice and**  
**broken rice**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC<sup>1</sup> of 25 July 1967 on the common organisation of the market in rice, and in particular Article 2 (4) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament;

Whereas the target price for husked rice must be fixed for a standard quality; whereas this standard quality should correspond as far as possible to the

average quality of round-grained rice harvested in the Community;

Whereas for this purpose the standard quality of husked rice fixed by Regulation No 362/67/EEC<sup>2</sup> may be maintained after 31 August 1968;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Sole Article*

From 1 September 1968 the introductory sentence to Article 1 of Regulation No 362/67/EEC shall read as follows:

'The standard quality in respect of which the target price for husked rice is fixed shall be as follows:'

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
