REGULATION (EEC) No 85/68 OF THE COUNCIL

of 23 January 1968

supplementing Regulation No 213/67/EEC establishing the list of representative markets
for pigmeat in the Community

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community;Having regard to Council Regulation No 121/67/
EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation
of the market in pigmeat, and in particular Article 4
(5) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the list of representative markets in pigmeat
in the Community was established by Regulation
No 213/67/EEC²;Whereas it has proved necessary to take the Luxem-
bourg and Esch group of markets as a representative
market only when Luxembourg does not impose
the quantity restrictions on imports of slaughtered
pigs provided for by the Protocol on the Grand
Duchy of Luxembourg, since application of theserestrictions has the effect of shielding the price of
this product from the free play of supply and
demand;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*The following paragraph shall be added to Article 1
of Regulation No 213/67/EEC:‘However, the Luxembourg and Esch group of
markets shall be taken as a representative market
only where, as regards slaughtered pigs, Luxem-
bourg has not had recourse to the provisions of
Article 1 (1) of the Protocol on the Grand Duchy
of Luxembourg.’*Article 2*This Regulation shall enter into force on the third
day following its publication in the *Official Journal
of the European Communities*.This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
