**REGULATION (EEC) No 2602/69 OF THE COUNCIL
of 18 December 1969**

on retaining the Management Committee procedure

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Regulation No 23¹ on the progressive establishment of a common organisation of the market in fruit and vegetables, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2512/69,² and in particular Article 15 thereof;

Having regard to Regulation No 24³ on the progressive establishment of a common organisation of the market in wine, as amended by Regulation No 92/63/EEC,⁴ and in particular Article 9 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 136/66/EEC⁵ of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organisation of the market in oils and fats, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2146/68,⁶ and in particular Article 40 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC⁷ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69,⁸ and in particular Article 28 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 121/67/EEC⁹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in pigmeat, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69, and in particular Article 26 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 122/67/EEC¹⁰ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in eggs, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 830/68,¹¹ and in particular Article 19 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 123/67/EEC¹² of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in poultrymeat, and in particular Article 19 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC¹³ of 25 July 1967 on the common organisation of the market in rice, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69, and in particular Article 28 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/67/EEC¹⁴ of 18 December 1967 on the common organisation of the market in sugar, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2485/69¹⁵ and in particular Article 42 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 234/68¹⁶ of 27 February 1968 on the establishment of a common organisation of the market in live trees and other plants, bulbs roots and the like, cut flowers and ornamental foliage, and in particular Article 16 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68¹⁷ of 27 June 1968 on the common organisation of the market in milk and milk

products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69, and in particular Article 32 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68¹ of 27 June 1968 on the common organisation of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69, and in particular Article 29 thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 865/68² of 28 June 1968 on the common organisation of the market in products processed from fruit and vegetables, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2463/69, and in particular Article 17 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament;

Whereas the above-mentioned Articles provide that at the end of the transitional period the Council, acting in accordance with the voting procedure laid down in Article 43 (2) of the Treaty on a proposal

from the Commission shall decide in the light of experience whether to retain or amend the provisions relating to the Management Committee procedure;

Whereas experience has demonstrated that it is desirable to retain that procedure beyond the transitional period;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The provisions governing the procedure to be followed by the Management Committees established in the various sectors of the common organisation of agricultural markets shall be retained beyond expiry of the transitional period provided for in Article 8 of the Treaty.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1970.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
