

REGULATION (EEC) No 405/69 OF THE COMMISSION

of 3 March 1969

amending Regulation No 158/67/EEC determining the coefficients of equivalence
between the different qualities of cereals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals, as last amended by Council Regulation (EEC) No 289/69² of 17 February 1969, and in particular Article 13 (4) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation No 158/67/EEC³ of 23 June 1967, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 213/68⁴ of 22 February 1968, determined the coefficients of equivalence between the qualities of cereals offered on the world market and the standard quality for which the threshold price is fixed;

Whereas certain qualities of common wheat from Australia, Romania and the USSR not shown in the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC are sometimes offered on the world market;

Whereas, for the purpose of determining c.i.f. prices, it is necessary to fix the coefficients of equivalence for those qualities in the light both of the Community standard quality and of the differences in price and characteristics between those qualities and the qualities listed in the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC;

Whereas the Management Committee for Cereals has not issued an Opinion within the time-limit set by its Chairman;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following shall be substituted for the 'Common Wheat' section of the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC:
