## REGULATION (EEC) No 571/70 OF THE COMMISSION

of 26 March 1970

determining the list of egg products covered by the provisions for the advance fixing of export refunds and the destination of such products

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 122/67/EEC<sup>1</sup> of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in eggs, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 436/70,<sup>2</sup> and in particular Article 9 (3) thereof;

Whereas Article 9 (2) of Regulation No 122/67/EEC provides for the advance fixing of export refunds; whereas Article 5 (3) of Council Regulation No 175/67/EEC<sup>3</sup> of 27 June 1967 laying down general rules for granting export refunds on eggs and criteria for fixing the amount of such refunds, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 437/70,<sup>4</sup> provides that such advance fixing may cover all products listed in Article 1 (1) (b) of Regulation No 122/67/EEC;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 204/69<sup>5</sup> of 28 January 1969 laying down general rules for granting export refunds on certain agricultural products exported in the form of goods not covered by Annex II to the Treaty and criteria for fixing the amount of such refunds, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 489/70,<sup>6</sup> provides that the system for fixing the rate of the refund in advance may be made to apply to eggs in shell exported as ovalbumin;

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

Done at Brussels, 26 March 1970.

Whereas the export potential of these products makes it advisable to provide for fixing refunds for each of them in advance;

Whereas exports to certain third countries which are distant from the Community are subject to special transport conditions and to the phasing of deliveries so that it is necessary to fix refunds for these destinations in advance; whereas, therefore, the list of these third countries should be determined;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Poultrymeat and Eggs;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The export refund provided for in Article 9 of Regulation No 122/67/EEC shall be fixed in advance, on application, for products listed in Annex I and exported to the countries listed in Annex II.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 April 1970.
