

REGULATION (EEC) No 1306/71 OF THE COMMISSION

of 23 June 1971

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1072/68 determining the bases for calculating the levy
on certain kinds of frozen beef and veal in respect of certain definitions

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68¹ of 27 June 1968 on the common organisation of the market in beef and veal as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1253/70,² and in particular Article 13 (5) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1072/68³ of 25 July 1968 on determining the bases for calculating the levy on certain kinds of frozen beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 643/69,⁴ defined certain cuts of frozen beef and veal to which the coefficients used in calculating the levy apply;

Whereas experience has shown that the definition of 'forequarters' is too limited and can lead to problems in trade; whereas it is therefore advisable to alter the definitions of this cut;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. The following shall be substituted for Article 6 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 1072/68:

'For the purposes of this Regulation "forequarters" means the front part of a carcass comprising all the bones and the scrag, neck and shoulder, with a minimum of four ribs and a maximum of ten whole or cut ribs, with or without the thin flank.'

2. The following shall be substituted for the description of the products listed under sub-heading No 02.01 A II (a) 2 (dd) 22 (aaa) in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1072/68:

'Forequarters, whole or cut into a maximum of five pieces, each quarter being in a single block; "compensated quarters" in two blocks, one of which contains the forequarter, whole or cut into a maximum of five pieces, and the other, the hindquarter, excluding the tenderloin, in one piece.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1971.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
