

REGULATION (EEC) No 1606/71 OF THE COMMISSION
of 26 July 1971

altering certain processing coefficients in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68
on the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68¹ of 23 July 1968 on the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1529/71,² and in particular Article 4 (1) (a) thereof;

Whereas the coefficient in column 4 of the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1529/71, representing the average quantity of oats required for the production of hulled grains (shelled or husked), sliced or kibbled is 1.60; whereas production in the Community of hulled grains intended primarily for foodstuffs requires a greater quantity of oats which may be estimated at approximately 180 kilogrammes; whereas, to prevent the market being disturbed as a result of the importation of hulled oat grains on

which a levy based on a coefficient of 1.60 would be charged, this coefficient should be altered to 1.80;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1052/68, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1529/71, the coefficient in column 4 for products falling within sub-headings 11.02 B I (b) 2 is hereby fixed at 1.80.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 August 1971.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
