REGULATION (EEC) No 2313/71 OF THE COUNCIL

of 29 October 1971

on the temporary partial suspension of the Common Customs Tariff duties on wine
originating in and coming from Algeria

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the
European Economic Community, and in particular
Article 43 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Having regard to the Opinion of the European
Parliament;

Whereas, following the entry into force of Council
Regulation (EEC) No 816/70¹ of 28 April 1970 laying
down additional provisions for the common
organisation of the market in wine, as last amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 2312/71,² it is desirable to
set up a provisional system with regard to Algeria
while awaiting a definitive system, in order to avoid
an interruption in the flow of wine exports, which
are of major importance for that country;

Whereas this provisional system, which must be the
same throughout the Community, must not
compromise the protection of the Community market
afforded by the above-mentioned Regulation; whereas
the desired objective should be attained by partial
suspension of the Common Customs Tariff duties
and observance of the reference price;

Article 1

1. The customs duties on imports into the
Community of wine of fresh grapes falling within
heading No ex 22.05 of the Common Customs Tariff,
originating in and coming from Algeria, shall be
equal to 60% of the Common Customs Tariff duties
applicable on the date of importation.

2. The provisions of paragraph 1 shall apply only
if the conditions set out in the second subparagraph
of Article 9 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 816/70 are
fulfilled.

However, for that subparagraph to be applied to the
case in point, the customs duties applicable in
pursuance of paragraph 1 shall be substituted for
those set out in the Common Customs Tariff.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November
1971.

It shall apply until 31 August 1972 at the latest.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
