## REGULATION (EEC) No 2830/71 OF THE COUNCIL

of 24 December 1971

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1599/71 laying down additional conditions with which imported wines for direct human consumption have to comply

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 816/70<sup>1</sup> of 28 April 1970 laying down additional provisions for the common organisation of the market in wine, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2504/71,<sup>2</sup> and in particular Article 28 (1) (b) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1599/71<sup>3</sup> of 20 July 1971 laid down additional conditions with which imported wines for direct human consumption have to comply; whereas Article 4 of that Regulation provides that such additional conditions shall apply from 1 January 1972; whereas in view of the

complicated nature of problems which have arisen on this subject it does not appear possible to keep to this date and therefore a later date should be fixed;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The date 1 April 1972 shall be substituted for the date 1 January 1972 in Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 1599/71.

*Article 2*This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
