REGULATION (EEC) No 2322/72 OF THE COUNCIL

of 31 October 1972

fixing the threshold price for olive oil for the 1972/73 marketing year

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC¹ of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organisation of the market in oils and fats, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1547/72,² and in particular the second paragraph of Article 4 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the threshold price must be fixed in such a way as to enable the selling price of the imported product, at the frontier crossing point referred to in Article 13 (2) of Regulation No 136/66/EEC, to be maintained at the level of the market target price; whereas, when the present costs incurred by the importer from

the c.i.f. stage are taken into account, the level of the threshold price should be maintained at 1.40 units of account below the level of the market target price;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The threshold price for olive oil for the 1972/73 marketing year shall be 78.20 units of account per 100 kilogrammes.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November 1972.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
