REGULATION (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 1408/74 OF THE COUNCIL

of 4 June 1974

adjusting the weightings applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Communities

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities ;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities laid down by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68 ⁽¹⁾ as last amended by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2/74 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Articles 64, 65 (2) and 82 of the said Staff Regulations and the first paragraph of Article 20 and Article 64 of the said Conditions of Employment ;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ;

Whereas, by reason of the substantial rise in the cost of living which has taken place in Belgium and in the other countries where officials and other servants of the European Communities are employed during the second half of 1973, the weightings applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants should be adjusted ;

Whereas the adjustment to remuneration and pensions provided for by this Regulation is made by way of advance on the adjustment to be made by the Council following the annual review of remuneration next September pursuant to Article 65 (1) of the Staff Regulations for a reference period running from 1 July 1973 to 30 June 1974,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. With effect from 1 January 1974 the weightings applicable to the remuneration of officials employed in the countries listed below shall be as follows :

Germany	116.8
France	147.9
Italy	126.6
Luxembourg	122.5
Netherlands	122.3

2. With effect from 1 January 1974 the weighting applicable to pensions in accordance with the second subparagraph of Article 82 (1) of the Staff Regulations shall be that given below for the Community country in which the person entitled to the pension declares his home to be :

Belgium	122.5
Germany	116.8
France	147.9
Italy	126.6
Luxembourg	122.5
Netherlands	122.3
United Kingdom	136.5

If a person entitled to a pension declares his home to be in a country other than those listed above, the weighting applicable to the pension shall be that for Belgium.

Article 2

Article 5 of Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2/74 is repealed with effect from 1 January 1974.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
