

REGULATION (EEC) No 888/74 OF THE COMMISSION

of 16 April 1974

on an invitation to tender for the export levy for husked long grained rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC ⁽¹⁾ of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by the Act of Accession ⁽²⁾ ;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2737/73 ⁽³⁾ of 8 October 1973 laying down general rules to be applied in the event of the rice market being disturbed, and in particular Article 4 (2) thereof ;

Whereas, having taken into account the current situation on the rice market, an invitation should be issued, for husked long grained rice, to tender for the export levy provided for in Article 2 (1), first indent of Regulation (EEC) No 2737/73 ;

Whereas the detailed rules relating to the tendering procedure to fix the export levy are contained in Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73 ⁽⁴⁾ of 23 November 1973 establishing the conditions for the application of the system of tendering for export levies for rice ;

Whereas, in order to allow the tenderers to have paddy rice processed into husked rice or to consider contracts of longer duration, provision should be made for a special rule on the period of validity of the export licences ;

Whereas the objective of the tendering procedure can be attained only if the successful tenderer fulfils all the commitments entered into at the moment of lodging his tender ; whereas among these commitments is the obligation to lodge an application for an export licence ; whereas the security for tender exacted when the tender is lodged can ensure that this obligation is respected ; whereas in default this security shall not be released if such an application has not been made ;

Whereas, in order to ensure equal treatment to all interested parties, it is necessary to provide that the effective period of validity of licences issued under the tendering procedure to successful tenderers will be identical ;

Whereas the smooth working of a procedure for tendering for export levies must be ensured ; whereas to this end it is appropriate to prescribe a minimum quantity as well as the period during which tenders can be lodged and the form of the communication of tenders lodged with the competent authorities ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. An invitation to tender shall be issued for the export levy provided for in Article 2 (1), first indent of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2737/73.
2. The invitation shall relate to husked long grained rice.
3. The invitation is open until 28 June 1974. During this period weekly invitations shall be issued for which the time limits for lodging of offers shall be down in the notice of the tender.
4. By way of derogation from Article 1 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73, the period which is required between publication of the notice of tender and the first date fixed for the deposit of tenders shall be 10 days.

Article 2

A tender shall be valid only if it relates to an amount of not less than 20 metric tons.

Article 3

An export licence issued in terms of this tender shall be valid for 90 days from its date of issue.

Article 4

When the commitment mentioned in Article 2 (3) (b) of Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73 is not respected the export licence shall not be issued and, in consequence, the security exacted under the provisions of Article 3 of that Regulation shall be forfeit.

Article 5

By way of derogation from the provisions of Article 8 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1373/70⁽¹⁾, the export licences issued under Article 8 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73 shall be considered for the purpose of determining their period of validity as if they had been issued on the day on which the tender was lodged.

Article 6

1. When the obligation to export has not been fulfilled, the security mentioned in Article 3 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73 shall be forfeit in respect of a quantity equal to the difference between :

- (a) 93 % of the net quantity indicated on the export licence, and
- (b) the net quantity actually exported.

2. However, if the exported quantity is less than 7 % of the net quantity indicated on the licence, the security shall be forfeit in totality.

3. On request by the titular holder, Member States may release parts of the security in proportion to the quantities of product for which the proof of export, in accordance with Article 7 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3197/73, has been delivered and in so far as that proof provides evidence that a quantity equal to at least 7 % of the net quantity indicated on the licence has been exported.

Article 7

The tenders lodged must reach the Commission through the intermediary of Member States at the latest one and a half hours after the end of the period for the weekly lodging of tenders as provided for in the notice of the tender. They must be communicated in the form indicated in the Annex.

When there are not tenders, Member States shall inform the Commission of this within the time limit indicated in the preceding paragraph.

Article 8

During the period in which Summer Time applies in Italy, the times fixed for the lodging of offers shall be regarded in that Member State as extended by one hour. During the period during which Summer Time does not apply in the United Kingdom and in Ireland, the times fixed for the lodging of offers shall be regarded in those Member States as brought forward by one hour.

Article 9

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
