

REGULATION (EEC) No 204/75 OF THE COMMISSION
of 28 January 1975
fixing the sluice-gate prices and levies for eggs

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 122/67/EEC ⁽¹⁾ of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in eggs, as last amended by the Act ⁽²⁾ concerning the conditions of accession and the adjustments to the Treaties, and in particular Articles 3 and 7 (1) thereof ;

Whereas sluice-gate prices and levies for the products specified in Article 1 (1) of Regulation No 122/67/EEC must be fixed quarterly in advance in accordance with the methods of calculation laid down in Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1918/74 ⁽³⁾ of 23 July 1974 fixing the sluice-gate prices and levies for eggs ;

Whereas, since sluice-gate prices and levies for eggs were by Regulation (EEC) No 2706/74 ⁽⁴⁾ last fixed for the period 1 November 1974 to 31 January 1975, new sluice-gate prices and levies must be fixed for the period 1 February to 30 April 1975 ; whereas such prices and levies should in principle be calculated by reference to the prices of feed grains over the period 1 May to 31 October 1974 ;

Whereas in fixing the sluice-gate prices to take effect on 1 November, 1 February and 1 May respectively, no account is to be taken of the trend of feed grain prices on the world market unless the price of the quantity of feed grain required varies by at least a specified minimum in relation to that used to calculate the sluice-gate price for the preceding quarter ; whereas by Council Regulation No 145/67/EEC ⁽⁵⁾ of 21 June 1967 laying down rules for calculating the

levy and the sluice-gate price for eggs, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1716/74 ⁽⁶⁾, this minimum was set at 3 % ;

Whereas the price of quantity of feed grain required varies by more than 3 % from that used for the previous quarter ; whereas this variation must accordingly be taken into account in fixing sluice-gate prices for the period 1 February to 30 April 1975 ;

Whereas in fixing the levies to take effect on 1 November, 1 February and 1 May respectively, no account is to be taken of the trend of feed grain prices on the world market unless at the same time a new sluice-gate price is fixed ;

Whereas, since a new sluice-gate price is to be fixed, account must be taken of the trend of feed grain prices in fixing the levies ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Poultrymeat and Eggs,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The levies provided for in Article 3 of Regulation No 122/67/EEC in respect of the products specified in Article 1 (1) of that Regulation and the sluice-gate prices provided for in Article 7 of that Regulation in respect of the like products shall be as shown in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 February 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
