

## COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2157/76

of 31 August 1976

amending Regulation (EEC) No 501/76 as regards the destinations of the butter-oil supplied to UNICEF as food aid

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community,Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization  
of the market in milk and milk products <sup>(1)</sup>, as last  
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 559/76 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in  
particular Article 6 (7) thereof,Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 501/76 of  
5 March 1976 concerning the repetition of an invita-  
tion to tender for the supply of butteroil bought on  
the Community market to UNICEF as food aid for  
Bangladesh <sup>(3)</sup>, provided for the supply of butteroil to  
UNICEF for Bangladesh in three lots; whereas after  
the contract has been awarded UNICEF requested  
that Lots B and C be delivered to Vietnam and under-  
took to cover the additional costs this change of desti-  
nation entailed; whereas the situation should be regu-  
larized by amending accordingly Regulation (EEC) No  
501/76;Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation  
are in accordance with the opinion of the Manage-  
ment Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

1. In Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 501/76,  
the destination stated for Lots B and C shall be  
amended as follows:

'Lot B: 200 metric tons for Vietnam, to be deliv-  
ered cif Singapore',

'Lot C: 200 metric tons for Vietnam, to be deliv-  
ered cif Singapore'.

2. The provisions of paragraph 1 shall not affect  
the maximum amounts set for the contract concerned.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day  
following its publication in the *Official Journal of  
the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
